REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES - JANUARY 26, 2012

PLACE: Gloucester Township Municipal Building

TIME: 7:30 PM

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: Tom Smith-Chair Person, Jay Nofer-Vice Chairperson, George Love-Secretary, Bob Davy-Treasurer and Trustees Laura Jevic, Sue Briggs and Michele Ordile.

Roll call was taken by sign in sheets. A motion to accept the Minutes of the August 28, 2011 meeting was made by George Love, seconded by Laura Jevic. All members vote in favor.

Tom Smith welcomed everyone to the meeting and introduced all members of the Board. Bob Davy gave the Treasurer's Report as follows: The Association's checking balance as of 8/25/11 was \$ 5,656.24. There were disbursements of \$ 3.00 for bank service charge and \$ 500.00 for championship jackets leaving a current balance of \$ 5,153.24. A motion to accept the report was made by George Love, seconded by Jay Nofer. All members voted in favor.

Tom Smith stated that the Association would be needing league commissioners for this year and anyone interested should contact anyone on the Board about participating. He further advised that forms were available tonight or on the S.J.G.S.A. web site for entering teams for this league year. Laura Jevic stated that all forms must be clear and legible for acceptance by S.J.G.S.A. The only form not available on the internet is the player transfer form. This must be requested from the Board. Application forms and league fees will due at the February 23 Meeting. Tom further advised that a By-Laws change was made and voted on at the August 25 , 2011 Meeting to increase the teams' Bond to \$ 100.00. Bob Davy has the remaining teams' Bond amounts from the 2011 league year.

Jay Nofer gave a presentation on the newly proposed open divisions in S.J.G.S.A. The teams in this division would be primarily established ASA/NAS Teams who would only play on Monday through Friday. These teams would also not be restricted to having only three excepted players on there rosters. Jay advised that additional information on these leagues is on the S.J.G.S.A. website. As of this time, the age groups are 10U, 12U and 14U. He further stated that the town teams would remain the same as in previous years.

The next Meeting will be Thursday, February 23, 2012 at 7:30 P.M. A motion to adjourn was made by George Love, seconded by Laura Jevic. All members voted in favor.
